



INVITATION TO BID

The City of McCall, Idaho is soliciting bids from Idaho Public Works Licensed and ICPI Certified Landscape Paver Contractors at the front desk office of City Hall at 216 E. Park Street until **9:00 AM MST on Thursday, May 10** for the following project:

Legacy Park Promenade Repairs – Fall 2018

At 9:15 AM, MST on Thursday, May 10, 2018, all proposals will be publically opened and read aloud at the American Legion Hall, 216 E. Park Street, McCall, Idaho.

The project consists of the removal of existing concrete slab and landscape paver bands and subgrade; re-grading to accommodate potential new base, synthetic edging material around planters, and installation of new pavers across the entire surface throughout a portion of the West end of the park promenade. In addition, other site improvements as bid alternates will include adjustments to existing pavers throughout the park and concrete repair/patch work on West end stair case. Funding for this project will be coming from, McCall Urban Renewal Agency, LOT, and City General Fund as a Recreation Funded Capital Improvement Project.

Sets of the documents including the plans and Project Manual (containing Bid forms, bidding instructions/conditions, draft contract documents, and specifications) will be available on Monday, April 30, 2018 for review at the City Hall front desk at 216 E. Park Street, 83638, 208-634-7142. Documents will be issued in either a PDF or paper format. Bidders will be required to pay a non-refundable cost of \$25.00 (including tax) for the paper document version, payable to the City of McCall.

A **pre-bid conference**, open to the public, will be held at the American Legion Hall, 216 E. Park Street on Wednesday, May 02, 2018 at 10:00AM. All potential bidders are **highly** encouraged to attend given the construction history and unique nature of this project.

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by cash, a certified check, bid bond, or cashier's check in the amount not less than 5% of the total amount bid, payable to the City of McCall. An Idaho Public Works License and ICPI Certification for paver installation is required to submit a bid.

Any objections to the contents or terms of the bidding instruction and project plans and specifications shall be raised (3) days prior to the bid opening, or it shall be deemed to have been waived.

The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
